In an effort to reassure you of your ability to make academic progress during the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic, you can opt for a change from a traditional letter grade to a "PC" grade or withdraw from a course for the Spring 2020 term.

Is Choosing the "PC" Grading Option Right for You?

Yes

- You found that learning online this semester inhibited your progress in your classes
- You had special circumstances that prevented you from performing to your typical standards
- You feel the letter grade does not reflect your academic ability

No

- You plan on applying to a four-year university after you receive your associate's degree. We cannot guarantee that the college of your choice will accept the "PC" grade
- You are planning to apply to the Health Science program including Nursing, Med Tech or RADX. This grade will not be accepted
- If you are currently enrolled in Nursing, RADX course
- You are on a Financial Aid appeal or are receiving Veteran's benefits
- The "PC" option cannot replace an "F" grade

Other Factors to Consider

- If you are on academic probation, you need to speak to your academic advisor before opting into a "PC" grade.
- The request to withdrawal or for the "PC" grad cannot be made before you receive your final letter grade
- The "PC" grade will not improve or harm your GPA
- This can adversely affect your Financial Aid disbursement

The Fine Print

- Make your decision carefully; once you decide to withdrawal or take the "PC" grade, it cannot be changed; you cannot petition to reinstate the letter grade
- The deadline to apply is June 22, 2020*. This allows you to see your final letter grade before making your decision
