Excelsior University Transfer Pathways

Excelsior University is committed to providing transfer pathways to students looking to progress from a 2-year to 4-year degree. Each student will be reviewed individually to identify transferability of approved outside sources of credit as it relates to an Excelsior degree program. Transferability of credit at Excelsior will be based upon the following:

- Transfer policies in effect at the time a student is admitted.
- Curriculum requirements in effect at the time a student is admitted.
- The final grade a student receives on outside sources of credit.
- The program a student applies to.
- The outside sources of credit a student has completed and how those credits apply to the selected program of study and degree requirements.

Transfer pathways stating "N/A" simply means there is no direct transfer pathway based upon the partner and Excelsior programs of study.
