This year's charity luncheon raised \$16,155 to support the Women of Wonder Scholarship Endowment Fund. During the event, four exceptional Cape May County Women received the Woman of Wonder Award; **Deborah Brasch**, executive director for Caring for Kids in Cape May Court House; **Christina Clemans**, managing broker for The Chris Clemans Group at Tim Kerr Sotheby's International Realty; **Amy Mahon**, partner and chief operating officer for Reich Asset Management; and **Denise Venturini-South**, commissioned Chaplain and founding director of Cape Hope.
