Awarded to Cape May County student who is a hardworking volunteer in the community.

Awarded to a student in good academic standing.

Awarded to a Cape May County student(s) with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Financial need considered.

Awarded to a returning student with a nontraditional career goal. Submit a written statement demonstrating leadership ability. Minimum 2.5 GPA.

John E. Stellman Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a sophomore who has demonstrated support to fellow students in their learning process. Minimum 2.8 GPA. Financial need.

WIBCA/GEMS Memorial Scholarship Fund

Awarded to a Cape May County minority student.

Edward James Yoa Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time student with a GPA of 3.5 or higher. Must be a resident of Atlantic or Cape May County.

SCIENCE/SOCIAL SCIENCE

Thomas C. Conover Memorial

For a graduating anthropology, biology or chemistry major continuing in a four-year science program. Merit only.

Donald P. Crescenzo, D.D.S. Scholarship

Awarded to biology, chemistry or health sciences student.

Joyce Dana Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a female student likely to go into research in any science field who demonstrates good academic record.

Dr. Oliver Henderson Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an Atlantic or Cape May county student with non-developmental credits in math/science at Atlantic Cape and/or NJ Marine Science Consortium. Merit only.

Science/Math Division Award

Awarded to second-year math/science student with minimum 3.25 GPA in major.

Ruth L. Williams Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an Atlantic Cape EOF graduate seeking a bachelor's degree in the social sciences.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Boardwalk Regents Club Scholarship

Awarded to a special needs student or a student pursuing a career working with disabled students.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Pick up an application from the Financial Aid Office and other campus locations. Also available at atlantic.edu.
- Complete the packet and return to Financial Aid before the deadline.
- Complete the Financial Need Statement in the packet if you wish to be considered for all scholarships.
- You will be considered for all scholarships for which you qualify. The Scholarship Committee meets in April to determine the recipients of each scholarship and award.
- You are encouraged to apply even if your major is not listed.
- Many scholarships are open to students in all areas.
- You will be notified in May whether you receive a scholarship or not.
- All recipients will be honored at a ceremony in May.

SCHOLARSHIP Q & A

Where do the funds for the scholarships come from and how are they distributed?

Scholarships are donated to or raised by Atlantic Cape Community College and the Atlantic Cape Foundation. The Scholarship Committee chooses recipients from the scholarship applications.

When are scholarship applications available?

Scholarship applications for all students are available in November in the Financial Aid Office and other buildings on all campuses. These applications are for scholarships for the following fall/spring academic year.

What are the criteria for the scholarships?

The criteria vary according to the donor. Many require a minimum GPA, some specify financial need, some are for a specific major, etc.

Do I need to apply for financial aid to qualify?

No; however, if you wish to be considered for a “need-based” scholarship, you must provide us with your financial information. Every student is encouraged to apply for Financial Aid.

Is there a separate process for culinary applicants?

Yes and no. Several scholarship applications are available each year. The main application, available in November, is for all students. Culinary scholarships for the following fall semester are awarded based on this application. An application that is ONLY for culinary students is available in the fall, which is used to determine spring awards. Two additional scholarships are offered to culinary students only during the year.

Are there any other scholarships I can apply for?

Yes. A binder is kept on the Financial Aid counter with blank applications. These are applications that are sent to us from other colleges, special interest groups, clubs, etc. Students are welcome to take applications and mail them to the address on the application.

Following is a partial list of the scholarships and awards that are awarded annually:

ACCOUNTING

William R. Conn Memorial

Awarded to a second-year, full-time accounting student with a GPA of 3.0 or better.

N.J. Association of Public Accountants

Awarded to a second-year accounting major who has completed 32 credits. Merit only.

Nicholas Rettino Memorial

Awarded to an accounting major who demonstrates financial need. Must have a GPA of 2.75 or better.

BUSINESS/COMMUNICATION

Baucus & Company Scholarship

Awarded to Cape May County student majoring in business.

Helen Dilks-Eshbach Scholarship

Awarded to full- or part-time Atlantic or Cape May County students majoring in business with a minimum 2.9 GPA and demonstrated financial need. Transferable.

Andy J Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time student majoring in business. Financial need preferred.

A & R Mack Foundation Scholarship

Awarded to an Atlantic County resident with financial need.

Gerri Black Creative Writing Scholarship

Awarded to a student studying English or communication with an interest in writing.

Libby Demp Forrest Moore Memorial Writing Scholarship

Awarded to a student interested in a career in journalism or writing. Financial need preferred.

Marsha S. Popick Foundation Scholarship

Awarded to a part-time communication major. Emphasis on academic performance.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT/CHILDCARE

Tanya Smith Memorial Child Care Scholarship

Awarded to a returning child development/child care major with a GPA of 2.5 or better.

COMPUTERS

Terence Hutchison Memorial Award

Awarded to a returning student with a minimum 2.5 GPA in computer courses. Demonstrated interest in computer science/technology.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE

Jamie Crescenzo Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time criminal justice major who resides in Atlantic or Cape May County. Financial need preferred.

CULINARY ARTS

Note: Additional scholarships are available for culinary majors through a separate application process. Contact Financial Aid for more information.

Nate Allen Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a culinary student.

Atlantic Cape Community College Restaurant Gala Scholarship

Must have completed five culinary courses and be recognized as outstanding in attendance and ethics. Financial need.

V. Lawrence Brice Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a culinary student.

Carême’s Scholarship

Awarded to a second-year culinary major with minimum 2.6 GPA and demonstrated financial need.

Filomena P. Caruso Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an outstanding culinary student with financial need.

Grace M. Caruso Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an outstanding culinary student with financial need.

Neide Robinson Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a culinary arts student.

Frances M. Zaberer Scholarship

Awarded to ACA students with good academic standing, financial need and a 3.0 GPA or better.

EDUCATION

Future Teacher Community Service Scholarship

Awarded to students with a GPA of 3.25 or higher with a history of community service.

Anita Metzger Scholarship

Awarded to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA and 28 credits, majoring in primary or child care education, and demonstrated financial need.

Jane Scharfetter Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full- or part-time education major. Minimum 2.5 GPA.

HISTORY

James H. Boyd Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time history major who is interested in pursuing a career in government or politics.

Samuel A. Donio Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a second-year history or education major, with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Demonstrated community service.

HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT

Jonathan Benanav Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a student working locally in the hospitality field with a minimum 3.0 GPA who is involved in student activities.

George C. Donaghue Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a second-year, full-time hospitality management major, with a minimum 2.5 GPA, who is an Atlantic or Cape May County resident.

LIBERAL ARTS

Arnold Kramer Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a liberal arts major. Financial need considered.

NURSING/ALLIED HEALTH

Grace M. Caruso Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to an outstanding nursing student with financial need.

Joy Eshbach Roehnert Scholarship

Awarded to a female Atlantic or Cape May County resident, age 30 or older, who is a nursing major, with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need preferred.

Walter Russell Eshbach Scholarship

Awarded to allied health majors with financial need.

Colonel John L. and Ruth M. Lee Scholarships

Awarded to nursing and allied health students, who are Atlantic County residents and high school graduates. Must be a second-year student with financial need and scholastic ability.

Nursing Program Scholarship

Awarded to a nursing student.

Marilyn Rhoads Miller Scholarship

Awarded to a nursing student with a 3.4 GPA or higher and financial need.

James D. Schofield Scholarship

For a nursing student in the clinical portion of the program with minimum “C” average and financial need.

Soroptimist International of Atlantic City Scholarship

Awarded to a full-time, second-year student studying health care.

SouthShore Foundation Health Education Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating student who is transferring to a baccalaureate program in a health-related field.

SouthShore Foundation Scholarship

For allied health and nursing students in the clinical portion of the program, with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Two faculty recommendations required. Merit only.

Alyce Van Sant Eshbach Scholarship

For a female Atlantic or Cape May County resident, age 30 or older, enrolled in an allied health major with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need preferred. Transferable.

Visiting Nurses Association of A.C. Scholarship

For a nursing student in the clinical portion of the program with minimum “C” average and financial need.

Margaret M. Wright Scholarship

For a second-year nursing student with a GPA of 3.0 or better, recommended by nursing faculty. Cape May County resident preferred.
